SAFETY REPORT

Wilko V:

Cold Weather Riding & Tire Grip

As we move into colder months, it's important to be aware of how temperature affects our motorcycle tires. Unlike cars, motorcycles rely heavily on tire grip of only 2 tires for stability and control, making it essential to understand how cold weather impacts performance. Your Harley likely has **cruiser/touring tires**, which don't require as much heat as sport tires but still benefit from some warming up, especially in cooler temperatures.



Tires Lose Grip Below 7°C (45°F)

Once temperatures drop below **7°C**, the rubber in our tires stiffens, reducing traction. This means longer stopping distances, less effective cornering, and an increased risk of slipping, especially on cold asphalt or damp roads.

- Below 20°C (68°F) Tires may feel stiff, reducing traction slightly.
- **Below 10°C (50°F)** Most street tires struggle to generate enough heat, increasing the risk of slipping.
- **Below 7°C (45°F)** Significant grip loss as the rubber hardens, making cornering and braking less effective.
- Near 0°C (32°F) and below Extreme loss of grip, risk of cold tearing, and possible ice formation on roads.

Warming Up Your Tires Matters

To maximize grip, it's crucial to **ride progressively for the first 10-15 minutes**. Avoid aggressive acceleration or hard braking until your tires have had time to warm up. Even on cool days, normal riding friction will gradually bring them to an optimal temperature.

Key Takeaways for Safe Riding

Ride smoothly and avoid sudden inputs until your tires warm up.

Check your tire pressure before heading out—cold weather lowers pressure.

Be extra cautious in shaded areas, bridges, and early morning rides where frost or black ice can form.

By keeping these points in mind, we can all stay safer on the road and enjoy our rides, no matter what the season.
