- TDMC is sending 8 technicians for training in January/February; they are very proud of their current team and their abilities to stay current and provide top service.

**July 2-4, 2015** – 15<sup>th</sup> Western Regional H.O.G.® Rally – Victoria, BC. Our Chapter won first prize for the largest Chapter turnout. The glass trophy will be displayed in the TDMC display case.

**September 12, 2015** – The Ride following September's meeting was lead by Dale; riders enjoyed a great lunch at Big Ridge Pub.

**September 13, 2015** – The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Rottie Run was represented by Vancouver H.O.G.<sup>®</sup> member Ralph.

September 18-20 – Ladies of Harley Summit in Langley, BC (the first in Canada) was sponsored by the Langley Chapter of H.O.G.® and Barnes H-D®. It was a huge success (see photos on Facebook). Tracey, Chris, Marlene, Pat and Juanita of Vancouver H.O.G.® attended; 85 women registered and 75 attended, with one woman riding from Edmonton; there were attendees from Edmonton, Calgary, Kamloops, Kelowna, Mount Vernon, Marysville, Tacoma, Olympia, as well as from the Vancouver Lower Mainland and Fraser Valley. Saturday morning was started with greetings from Len Bowman, Western Regional Director of H.O.G.® and Kevin Chow, Marketing Manager for Barnes H-D®. The day then continued with seminars on wellness/yoga, Women's Cancer (Skin and Breast), Rider Safety on Solo rides. Friday night the ladies enjoyed wine tasting, fashion show, games. There were 15 vendors with everything from jewellery, glass, spices, nail art, etc.; a Basket Raffle (each chapter was asked to bring one ) was held on Saturday evening along with door prizes and a silent auction; a Dinner/dance with a live band (Rhythm Street) on Saturday night.
