MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR CHRIS FERGUSON:

- We have raised a total of \$1,500 towards the purchase of a portable defibrillator. \$800 was raised through member donations; \$400 was donated by TDMC; and one anonymous member generously contributed \$300. The executive will work with member Dan to determine the best unit to purchase. It is valued at approximately \$1,600 so the Chapter will cover the additional costs. Thanks to everyone who contributed. The unit will be housed at TDMC, but will be taken by members on any overnight rides during the year.
- As mentioned at the last meeting, Len Bowman has stepped down as HOG® Regional Director. Any members who are interested in applying for this position can view the job description on the HOG International website and application. Len advised that members "need a strong liver" for the position, but seriously....work done through this position includes contract review (for regional rallies, etc.), legal issues, chapter visits, etc. There is considerable travel involved, however the costs are covered by HOG International.
